Denise Floyd and Clarence Fortney with the Great Plains Technology Center Foundation were the guest speakers. The group's Cornerstone Campaign is underway through March 17.

Floyd said the foundation was formed more than 40 years ago to help students pay for costs associated with their education at GPTC. In that time, the foundation has provided more than \$4.2 million in scholarships and grants to over 6,700 students. Floyd said the assistance has been the difference maker for some students to complete their career programs. She said if they're struggling financially, it's hard for them to concentrate on their schooling.

Fortney said the foundation supports both the Lawton and Frederick campuses. He said students have been awarded grants for emergencies that include car problems, electric bills or other obstacles that could prevent them from being successful. The GPTC programs have also helped with auto repairs, wiring at homes, and HVAC issues.

The foundation receives support from many organizations including the McMahon Foundation. Employees at GPTC make up the next largest group of supporters, because Fortney said they see the impact the assistance has firsthand. Donations may be made by individuals or businesses.
