Eric Sharum with the Oklahoma Sports Network was the guest speaker. He is celebrating his 38th year in broadcasting and 7th in sports streaming services.

Oklahoma Sports Network now provides streaming sports coverage for 11 schools, including all three Lawton high schools, Cache, Elgin, Altus, Del City and Yukon.

In addition to sports, Sharum said his company has expanded its digital reach with non-sports programming through Oklahoma Life TV. It offers feature programming that highlights local events, such as the Lawton-Fort Sill Freedom Festival and the Apache Rattlesnake Festival.

Sharum said the expansion of apps and digital streaming platforms, including Apple, Google, Roku and Amazon Fire TV has increased the popularity of OSN and Oklahoma Life TV. He said they can track their followers from all over the world. The majority, about 52-percent, are women. Casting technology allows users to easily stream content to their TVs at home. Lately, a spike in men, 18-24 years old, has been accessing the network's content on YouTube. The
